ORDINANCE NO. 05-009

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTION 2.36.040 (SERVICES TO RESIDENTS OUTSIDE CITY) OF CHAPTER 2.36 (LIBRARY DEPARTMENT)

THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance shall be of a permanent nature and shall become a part of the City of Palmer Code of Ordinances.

Section 2. Severability. If any provisions of this ordinance, or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.


Section 3. Subsection 2.36.040 is hereby amended to read as follows (new language is underlined and deleted language is stricken out):

2.36.040 Services to residents outside the city.

The city may enter into an agreement with the Matanuska-Susitna Borough to provide library services to residents who reside outside the city. Said agreement is subject to city council approval. Fees charged for such services shall be consistent with those established by the Matanuska-Susitna Borough.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
