AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6.04.010 (DEFINITIONS) OF TITLE 6 (ANIMALS) OF THE PALMER MUNICIPAL CODE

The City of Palmer ordains:

<u>Section 1.</u> Classification. This ordinance shall be permanent in nature and shall be incorporated into the Palmer Municipal Code.

<u>Section 2.</u> Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

<u>Section 3.</u> Section 6.04.010 is hereby amended to read as follows (new language is underlined and deleted language is stricken out):

Chapter 6.04

DEFINITIONS

Sections: 6.04.010 Definitions.

"Exotic animal" means any live monkey, alligator, crocodile, cayman, raccoon, skunk, fox, bear, sea mammal, poisonous snake, member of the feline family other than domestic cat (Felis domesticus), member of the canine family, including a wolf/dog hybrid, other than domestic dog (Canis familiaris) or any other animal that would require a standard of care or control greater than that required for customary household pets or common domestic farm animals.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
