ORDINANCE NO. 06-019

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PALMER MUNICIPAL CODE SUBSECTIONS 3.16.040 N AND 3.016.050 N; SPECIFICALLY TO ADDRESS THE TAXABILITY OF SERVICE FEES AND COMMISSIONS REGARDING TRAVEL AGENCIES

THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Classification. This ordinance shall be permanent in nature and shall be incorporated into the Palmer Municipal Code.

<u>Section 2.</u> Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Section 3.16.040 N is hereby amended to read as follows (new language is underlined and deleted language is stricken):

3.16.040 Examples of taxed transactions.

N. Services rendered by lawyers, accountants, shoe repair shops, carpenters and cabinetmakers, house painters and decorators, tinsmiths and sheet iron workers, watchmakers, radio and television advertising, photographers (including all film development), printing establishments, garages, mechanics and machinists, plumbers and electricians, welders and stove cleaners, and services of all other tradesmen, craftsmen and professional practitioners and service fees (except commissions) charged by travel agencies; and

Section 4. Section 3.16.050 N is hereby amended to read as follows (new language is underlined and deleted language is stricken):

3.16.050 Exceptions.

N. Interstate air, train and boat fares; Sales of air, train, boat, cruise line or bus tour transportation, car rentals, or accommodations, where the underlying service is provided outside the city, and commissions related to such sales.

Section 5. Effective Date. Ordinance No. 06-019 shall take effect upon adoption by the City of Palmer City Council.
