ORDINANCE NO. 08-002

AN ORDINANCE OF THE PALMER CITY COUNCIL ENACTING PALMER MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 2.11.030, DEPUTY CITY CLERK

THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA ORDAINS:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance shall be permanent in nature and shall be incorporated into the Palmer Municipal Code.

Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.


Section 3. Section 2.11.030 is hereby adopted to read as follows:


2.11.030 Deputy City Clerk.

- A. The clerk shall serve as appointing authority for and appoint all positions in the clerk's office.
- B. In the temporary absence of the city clerk, the deputy city clerk is authorized to act on behalf of the city clerk, with all the powers and obligations of the city clerk.
- C. The deputy city clerk shall be empowered to sign all documents in the name of the city clerk, subscribing his or her personal signature as deputy city clerk.

Section 4. Effective Date. Ordinance No. 08-002 shall take effect upon adoption by the City of Palmer City Council.
