ORDINANCE NO. 10-020

AN ORDINANCE OF THE PALMER CITY COUNCIL AMENDING PALMER MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 2.05.060 MAYOR PRO TEMPORE TO AMEND THE TITLE TO DEPUTY MAYOR AS APPROVED BY THE CITY OF PALMER VOTERS IN THE OCTOBER 5, 2010, ELECTION

THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Classification. This ordinance shall be permanent in nature and shall be incorporated into the Palmer Municipal Code.

<u>Section 2.</u> Severability. If any provisions of this ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstances are held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to the other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

<u>Section 3.</u> Palmer Municipal Code Chapter Section 2.05.060 is amended to read as follows (new language is underlined and deleted language is stricken):

2.05.060 Deputy Mayor pro tempore.

- A. At the first meeting following the regular city election, council shall elect from its membership a <u>deputy</u> mayor pro tempore and temporary <u>an alternate deputy</u> mayor pro tempore to serve in the absence of the mayor;
- B. The <u>deputy</u> mayor pro tempore-shall succeed to the office of mayor when a vacancy occurs in that office and shall have and exercise the powers and duties of the mayor when the mayor is absent or unable to perform the duties of office. When a doubt exists concerning the ability of the mayor to perform the duties of office, the council shall, by resolution, determine whether the <u>deputy</u> mayor pro tempore shall act in the place of the mayor. The determination shall stand until the council determines that the disability or inability ceases.

Section 4. Effective date. Ordinance No. 10-020 shall take effect upon adoption of the Palmer City Council.
