ORDINANCE NO. 102

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PAYMENTS FOR CITY
COUNCILMEN AND THE MAYOR, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE
NO. 80.

THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Repealer. Ordinance No. 80 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Payment for Regular Meetings. The City shall pay to each Councilman the sum of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) for each regular meeting of the city council attended by such councilman, and the sum of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) to the mayor for each regular meeting so attended, which payment shall be in lieu of individual expense accounts. Payment shall be made monthly, and no payment shall be made for attendance at other than regular meetings.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective as to any mayor or councilman duly elected or appointed after its passage, approval and publication. Publication of this ordinance shall be by posting a copy hereof on the city hall bulletin board for a period of ten days following its passage and approval.
