ORDINANCE NO. 11-006

AN ORDINANCE OF THE PALMER CITY COUNCIL AMENDING PALMER MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 2.04.100 ORDER OF BUSINESS, TO REORDER THE BUSINESS AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE CITY ATTORNEY'S REPORT

THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA ORDAINS:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance shall be permanent in nature and shall be incorporated into the Palmer Municipal Code.

Section 2. Severability. If any provisions of this ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstances are held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to the other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Palmer Municipal Code Section 2.04.110 is amended to read as follows (new language is underlined and deleted language is stricken):

2.04.110 Order of business.


At every regular meeting of the city council the order of business shall be as follows:

- A. Call to order;
- B. Roll call;
- C. Pledge of allegiance;
- D. Approval of agenda:
 1. Approval of consent agenda;
 2. Minutes of previous meetings;
- E. Communications and appearance requests;
- F. Reports
 1. City manager's report
 2. City clerk's report
 3. Mayor's report

- 4. City Attorney's Report
- G. Audience participation;
- H. Public hearings;
- I. Action memoranda;
- J. Unfinished business;
- K. New business;
- L. Record of items placed on the table;
- M. Audience participation;
- N. Council comments;
- O. Adjournment.

Section 4. Effective Date. Ordinance No. 11-006 shall take effect upon adoption by the City of Palmer City Council.
