Ordinance No. 13-007

An Ordinance of the Palmer City Council Amending Palmer Municipal Code Section 4.30.080 Bereavement leave, to Further Define the Term Immediate Family

THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA ORDAINS:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance shall be permanent in nature and shall be incorporated into the Palmer Municipal Code.

Section 2. Severability. If any provisions of this ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstances are held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to the other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.


Section 3. Section 4.30.080 is hereby amended to read as follows (new language is underlined and in blue and deleted language is stricken and in red):


4.30.080 Bereavement leave.

- A. Regardless of probation status, full-time employees will receive three (3) days of paid bereavement leave for the death of an employee's immediate family member (spouse, children, grandchildren, grandparents, mother, father, sister, or brother. For purposes of this section, in-laws are not included the term immediate family member.)
- B. The employee shall provide appropriate documentation of death to the personnel officer.

Section 4. Effective Date. Ordinance No. 13-007 shall take effect upon adoption by the City of Palmer City Council.
