Ordinance No. 14-026

An Ordinance of the Palmer City Council Amending Portions of Palmer Municipal Code Title 6 Animals, Providing for Fines for Violations

THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA ORDAINS:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance shall be permanent in nature and shall be incorporated into the Palmer Municipal Code.

Section 2. Severability. If any provisions of this ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstances are held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to the other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Palmer Municipal Code section 6.14.060 is hereby amended to read as follows (new language is underlined and deleted language is stricken):

6.14.060 Owner compliance.

- A. The owner shall comply with all the requirements of the chief's order within 10 business days of notification. Personal notification shall be made by a Palmer police department officer.
- B. In addition, the owner shall notify the chief within the 10-business-day period that the owner has complied with all the requirements of the order. If within the 10-business-day period the owner fails to comply or fails to so notify the chief, the owner shall be fined as stated in PMC 6.28.010~~(C)~~.

Section 4. Palmer Municipal Code section 6.28.010 is hereby amended to read as follows (new language is underlined and deleted language is stricken):

6.28.010 Fine Penalty.

A violation of this title is an offense punishable by the fine established in the current, adopted budget.


- ~~A. The penalty for owning a vicious animal at large, a dangerous animal at large and all other violations shall be as established in the current, adopted budget.~~
- ~~B. Penalties for an owner's failure to meet any of the duties set out in PMC 6.14.020(D) shall be as established in the current, adopted budget.~~

Section 5. Effective Date. Ordinance No. 14-026 shall take effect on January 1, 2015.
