## Ordinance No. 14-039

An Ordinance of the Palmer City Council Amending Palmer Municipal Code Section 10.04.050 Parking Prohibitions During Snow Accumulation or Drifting Snow **Conditions** 

THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA ORDAINS:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance shall be permanent in nature and shall be incorporated into the Palmer Municipal Code.

Section 2. Severability. If any provisions of this ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstances are held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to the other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Palmer Municipal Code section 10.04.050 is hereby amended to read as follows (new language is underlined and deleted language is stricken):

## 10.04.050 Parking prohibitions during snow accumulation and/or drifting snow conditions-winter months.

- A. When an accumulation of two or more inches of snowfall or drifting snow conditions exist, overnight parking is prohibited during the period of 2:00 AM to 6:00 AM on all City streets and rights-of-way in commercial, industrial, or public districts to facilitate snow removal . Commercial, Industrial or Public Districts. When an accumulation of two or more inches of snowfall in the previous 96 hours and/or drifting snow conditions exist, overnight parking is prohibited from October 1st to April 30th during the period of 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. on all city streets and rights of way in commercial, industrial or public districts.
- B. When an accumulation of two or more inches of snowfall or drifting snow conditions exist, parking is prohibited on all City streets and rights of way in all residential districts to facilitate snow removal. Residential Districts. When an accumulation of two or more inches of snowfall in the previous 96 hours and/or drifting snow conditions exist, parking is

 $\underline{\text{Section 4.}}$  Effective Date. Ordinance No. 14-039 shall take effect upon adoption by the City of Palmer City Council.
