Ordinance No. 14-040-Z-6

An Ordinance of the Palmer City Council Amending the Zoning Map to Revise the Zoning Designation of Tract B, Mountain Rose East, Phase I, located in Section 4, Township 17 North, Range 2 East, Seward Meridian, Alaska from R-2 Low Density Residential with Special Limitations to R-2 Low Density Residential

THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Classification. This ordinance shall be permanent in nature and shall be incorporated into the Palmer Municipal Code.

<u>Section 2.</u> Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

<u>Section 3.</u> Authority and legislative findings. Pursuant to 17.80.040, the City Council hereby adopts the following zoning map amendment in accordance with the legislative findings set below:

WHEREAS, the City of Palmer Planning and Zoning Commission (the Commission) received an application on August 4, 2014 from Kathy Martin, Vice President of Northrim Bank, owner and Gordon and Cindy Richmond, proposed purchasers of Tract B, Mountain Rose East, Phase I located in Section 4, Township 17 North, Range 2 East, Seward Meridian, Alaska to rezone the subject property from R-2 Low Density Residential with Special Limitations to R-2 Low Density Residential; and

WHEREAS, the Commission duly gave required notices, held its required public hearing on October 16, 2014, made a written report of its decision as to such need, justification and effect of the change of zoning in Commission Resolution 14-006, and voted unanimously to recommend that such amendment to the zoning map be approved; and

WHEREAS, the Commission adopted finding of fact in Commission Resolution 14-006 as to the need, justification and effect of the change of zoning on October 16, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the City Council duly gave required notices, held its required public hearing on this date, and has duly considered the request to rezone the property, all evidence and testimony presented including any comments of the persons attending the public hearing, the findings of fact set forth in Planning and Zoning Commission Resolution 14-006, and the recommendation of the Commission; and

<u>Section 4.</u> The City of Palmer Zoning Districts map dated March 2012 is hereby amended to revise the zoning designation of Tract B, Mountain Rose East, Phase I located in Section 4, Township 17 North, Range 2 East, Seward Meridian, Alaska from R-2 Low Density Residential with Special Limitations to R-2 Low Density Residential.

<u>Section 5.</u> Effective Date. Ordinance 14-040-Z-6 shall take effect upon adoption by the Palmer City Council.
