Ordinance No. 15-002

An Ordinance of the Palmer City Council Amending Palmer Municipal Code Section 4.10.070 Temporary Assignments

THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Classification. This ordinance is permanent in nature and shall be incorporated into the Palmer Municipal Code.

<u>Section 2</u>. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

<u>Section 3.</u> Section 4.10.070 is hereby amended to read as follows (new language is underlined and deleted language is stricken out):

4.10.070 Temporary assignments.

- A. Temporary Assignments. Employees may be assigned temporarily to perform duties of a higher classification for purposes of training and/or demonstration of skill leading to possible promotion, or to fill vacancies, for a period of up to 14 calendar days without change of classification for pay purposes. (Pay at step level 1 at the level of the temporary assignment or the next step level that is greater than the employee's current wages.)
- B. Acting City Manager or Acting City Clerk. <u>The acting city manager or acting city clerk shall receive the following compensation:</u>
 - <u>1.</u> Beginning on the fifteenth calendar day the employee shall receive a 10 percent increase of the acting employee's regular rate of pay while in acting status; or
 - 2. As directed by the council.

<u>Section 4.</u> Effective Date. Ordinance No. City of Palmer City Council.	15-002 shall take effect upon adoption by the
