## Ordinance No. 16-012

## An Ordinance of the Palmer City Council Amending Palmer Municipal Code Section 4.15.020 (I)(5) (Eligibility List)

THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Classification. This ordinance is permanent in nature and shall be incorporated into the Palmer Municipal Code.

<u>Section 2</u>. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

<u>Section 3.</u> Section 4.15.020 (I)(5) is hereby amended to read as follows (new language is underlined and deleted language is stricken out):

## 4.15.020 (I)(5)

The period during which an eligibility list remains in effect shall be determined in writing by the department director upon the establishment of such list, but the period shall not exceed 24 months six months from the close of the application period for the position. If the department director chooses and receives city manager approval to commence the recruitment and selection procedure to fill a job position for which an eligibility list exists, then the eligibility list ceases to be effective.

<u>Section 4.</u> Effective Date. Ordinance No. 16-012 shall take effect upon adoption by the City of Palmer City Council.
