## CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA ORDINANCE NO. 208

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 118 EXEMPTING CERTAIN PROPERTIES FROM TAXATION.

THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Classification. This ordinance shall be of a permanent nature and shall become a part of the City of Palmer Code of Ordinances.

Section 2. Severability. If any provisions of this ordinance, or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Amendment to Ordinance No. 118. Section 1(d) of Ordinance No. 118 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1(d). All property required to be exempt from general taxation by Alaska Statutes 29.53.020 is hereby exempted, together with the household furniture and personal effects of a head of a family or householder.

Section 4. Publication and Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective ten days after its adoption and publication shall be by posting a copy hereof on the City Hall bulletin board for a period of ten days following its adoption, and notice of public hearing shall be given by such posting at least five days before final passage.
