

## CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA

## ORDINANCE NO. 243

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE ORDER OF BUSINESS FOR THE CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS FOR THE CITY OF PALMER AND AMENDING SECTION 2.08.080 OF CHAPTER 2.08 OF TITLE 2 OF THE PALMER MUNICIPAL CODE.

THE CITY OF PALMER, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance shall be of a permanent nature and shall become a part of the City of Palmer Code of Ordinances.

Section 2. Severability. If any provisions of this ordinance, or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. That Section 2.08.080 of Chapter 2.08 of Title 2 of the Palmer Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.08.080 Order of Business. At every regular meeting of the city council the order of business shall be as follows:

- A. Call to order;
- B. Roll call;
- C. Pledge of allegiance;
- D. Minutes of previous meetings;
- E. Communications and appearance requests (requests shall be in writing, submitted to the city manager, and may be assigned an appropriate place on the agenda by him. All presentations to the Council shall be limited to five minutes, unless otherwise ordered by the council);
- F. Audience participation (all presentations to the Council shall be limited to two minutes per person and also limited to a total time of not more than 30 minutes);
- G. Hearings, ordinances and resolutions;
- H. Bids;
- I. Old business;
- J. New business;
- K. City manager's report;
- L. Borough representative's report;
- M. Audience participation;
- N. Council comments;
- O. Adjournment;


Section 4. Publication and Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective ten days after its adoption and publication shall be by posting a copy hereof on the City Hall bulletin board for a period of ten days following its adoption, and it shall be published by being printed and included in the Palmer Municipal Code at its next regular supplementation and printing. A notice of public hearing shall be given by such posting at least five days before final passage.
