

CITY OF PALMER, ALASKAORDINANCE NO. 27 *Repealed; See Ordinance #37*

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LOCATION AND PLACEMENT  
OF ELECTRIC POWER POLES, TELEPHONE POLES, OR OTHER  
TYPE OF WIRE CARRYING POLES, ON PRIVATE PROPERTY IN  
THE CITY OF PALMER.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF PALMER, ALASKA:

SECTION I. That whenever and wherever electric power poles, telephone poles or other type of wire carrying poles are placed by power generation and distribution agencies or companies and telephone operation and service agencies or companies, or other agencies or companies who maintain pole lines, on private property located within the corporate limits of the City of Palmer, said electric power poles and telephone poles, or other type of wire carrying poles, shall be placed on said private property at any point where the owner and the agency shall determine, but in no event shall said poles be placed closer than two feet from the street and/or alley side of said private property line.

That an emergency is hereby declared to exist; that the usual rules of procedure be suspended, and that this Ordinance shall be read in full, and again by its title and placed upon its final passage by the approval by the \_\_\_\_\_.
