ORDINANCE NO. 29

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12 OF ORDINANCE NO. 12
 "AN ORDINANCE DEFINING MISDEMEANORS IN THE CITY OF
 PALMER, PROVIDING PUNISHMENT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY
 OF PALMER, ALASKA, THAT:

Section 12 of Ordinance No. 12 be amended to read as follows:

"Section 12. Carrying Concealed Weapons, and carrying pistols, revolvers and side arms, and other weapons, in public places in the City of Palmer. Any person or persons, who shall carry any fire arm or deadly weapon of any kind, in a concealed manner, about his, or her person, within the corporate limits of the City of Palmer, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, PROVIDED that peace officers shall be exempt from the provisions of this section. Any person or persons who shall carry into any public bar, theatre, business house or any other public place within the corporate limits of the City of Palmer, regardless of whether concealed or openly displayed, any pistol, revolver, side arm, or other weapon, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or imprisonment in the City Jail for not more than thirty (30) days.

For the purposes of this Section, the word-"weapon" shall mean any inherently dangerous instrument which might or could be used for hunting purposes or purposes of inflicting injuries upon other persons, and shall not include hunting knives carried in sheaths attached to belt or other accessory of dress and openly displayed."

That an emergency is hereby declared to exist; that the usual rules of procedure be suspended, and that this Ordinance shall be read in full, and again by its title and placed upon its final passage by the approval by the Common Council.
