ORDINANCE NO. 31

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 3, Sub-Section (a) of "AN (14)
ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR LICENSES FOR ALL TRADES, BUSINESSES,
AND PROFESSIONS, OPERATED, CONDUCTED OR CARRIED ON IN THE
CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA"

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF PALMER, ALASKA, THAT:

Article 3, "License Year", sub-section (a), providing for the
payment of all license fees not specifically excepted to become due on
February 15 annually, shall be amended to read as follows:

- (a) The license year shall begin January 1st of each year and shall
terminate atmidnight December 31st of said year. The license
fees shall be due January 1st annually.

That an emergency is hereby declared to exist; that the usual rules
of procedure be suspended, and that this ordinance shall be read in full,
and again by its title and placed upon its final passage by the approval
by the _____
