## ORDINANCE NO. 336

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.08.070 - EXECUTIVE SESSION.

THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance shall be of a permanent nature and shall become a part of the City of Palmer Code of Ordinances.

Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance, or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Section 2.08.070 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.08.070 Executive Session. The council may go into executive session after first convening the meeting as a public meeting. The question of holding an executive session to discuss matters that come within the subjects listed hereafter in this section shall be determined by a majority vote of the body. No subjects may be considered at the executive session except those mentioned in the motion calling for the executive session unless auxiliary to the main question. No action may be taken at the executive session.

The following subjects may be discussed in executive session:

1. Potential or pending litigation to which the City may become or is a party;
2. Any matter, the immediate public knowledge of which would tend to adversely affect the finances of the City;
3. Any matter, the immediate knowledge of which would tend to defame or prejudice the character or reputation of any person;
4. Any other matter the discussion of which in executive session is authorized or required by law.

Section 4. Publication and Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and publication and shall be by posting a copy hereof on the City Hall bulletin board for a period of ten (10) days following its adoption, and it shall be published by being printed and included in the Palmer Municipal Code at its next regular supplementation and printing. A notice of public hearing shall be given by such posting a least five (5) days before final passage.
