

ORDINANCE NO. 41

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 21, SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 14, AND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR LICENSES FOR ALL TRADES, BUSINESSES AND PROFESSIONS, OPERATED, CONDUCTED OR CARRIED ON IN THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALMER, ASLAKA:

That Article 21, Section 4 thereof of Ordinance No. 14 be and the same hereby is amended as follows; and the annual license fee for the following business shall be:

Transient Merchants or Traders.....	25.00 for 1 to 30 days, and a cash bond, the amount of which shall be set by the City Clerk, but not to exceed \$25.00, shall be posted and deposited with the City Clerk for the purpose of insuring the filing of a sales tax return by the licensee on the sales made in the City, such bond to be refunded upon the filing of a sales tax return upon the expiration of the license or upon the statement of the licensee that he has finished the tour of the trading in the city for the period of the license.
