ORDINANCE NO. 427

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3.20.040 (PURCHASE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY) AND THE TITLE OF SECTION 3.20.050 (PURCHASE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OVER TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS--BIDDING PROCEDURES) OF CHAPTER 3.20--PURCHASING OF THE PALMER MUNICIPAL CODE.

THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance shall be of a permanent nature and shall become a part of the City of Palmer Code of Ordinances.

Section 2. Severability. If any provisions of this ordinance, or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Section 3.20.040 Purchase of personal property is hereby amended to read as follows:

3.20.040 Purchase of personal property. The city manager may purchase personal property only as authorized by the council and upon competitive bids, except as follows:

A. The city manager may purchase budgeted personal property in the amount of seven thousand five hundred dollars without council approval, competitive bid, signature of the city clerk or approval by the city attorney.

Section 4. The Title of Section 3.20.050 is hereby amended to read as follows:


3.20.050 Purchase of personal property over seven thousand five hundred dollars--Bidding procedures.



Section 5. Publication and Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption. Publication shall be by posting a copy hereof on the City Hall bulletin board for a period of ten (10) days following its adoption, and further it shall be published by being printed and included in the Palmer Municipal Code at its next regular supplementation and printing. A notice of public hearing shall be given by such posting at least five (5) days before final passage.
