ORDINANCE NO. 446

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.20.010(A)--(CREATION--OFFICERS--MEMBERSHIP) AND SECTION 2.20.100 (MEETINGS) OF CHAPTER 2.20-PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE PALMER MUNICIPAL CODE.

THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance shall be of a permanent nature and shall become a part of the City of Palmer Code of Ordinances.

Section 2. Severability. If any provisions of this ordinance, or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Section 2.20.010(A) is amended to read as follows:

2.20.010 Creation--Officers--Membership. A. There is created a city planning commission which shall consist of five members who shall be nominated by the mayor and confirmed by the city council.

Section 4. Section 2.20.100 is amended to read as follows:

2.20.100 Meetings. A. The commission shall establish rules of procedure, provided: there shall be a regular monthly meeting of the commission, which shall be open to the public. Permanent records or minutes shall be kept of the commission's proceedings, and such minutes shall record the vote of each member upon every question. Every decision or finding shall immediately be filed in the office of the city clerk and shall be a public record open to inspection by any person.


B. Commission members shall be compensated at the rate of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per special or regular meeting attended.

Section 4. Publication and Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption. Publication shall be by posting a copy hereof on the City Hall bulletin board for a period of ten (10) days following its adoption, and further it shall be published by being printed and included in the Palmer Municipal Code at its next regular supplementation and printing. A notice of public hearing shall be given by such posting at least five (5) days before final passage.
