

## CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA

## ORDINANCE NO. 472

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.04.040, (QUALIFICATIONS--TERMS--SALARIES) OF CHAPTER 2.04 (CITY COUNCIL) OF THE PALMER MUNICIPAL CODE.

THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance shall be of a permanent nature and shall become a part of the City of Palmer Code of Ordinances.

Section 2. Severability. If any provisions of this ordinance, or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Section 2.04.040, is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.04.040 Qualifications--Terms--Salaries. A. To be eligible to file a nominating petition for election to a city office, a person must be a qualified voter of the city and must have been a resident of the city or of territory annexed to the city, or must have had a combination of residence in the city and in the annexed territory, for a continuous period of not less than one year immediately preceding the date of the election.

B. The council shall consist of the mayor and six council members.

C. The terms of office of the mayor and of each councilmember shall be as prescribed in the Charter.

D. The compensation of each councilmember shall be:

1. The mayor shall receive seventy-five dollars per regular meeting and each councilmember shall receive fifty dollars per regular meeting;


2. The mayor and each councilmember shall receive ten dollars per special meeting.

Section 4. Publication and Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the Council and preclearance by the U.S. Department of Justice. Publication shall be by making copies available to the public, and further it shall be published by being printed and included in the Palmer Municipal Code at its next regular supplementation and printing. Publication may also be made by posting a copy hereof on the City Hall bulletin board for a period of ten (10) days following its adoption. A notice of public hearing shall be given by such posting at least five (5) days before final passage.
