

CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA

ORDINANCE NO. 482

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 13.08.020(F) (INITIATION OF SERVICE-CONNECTION-FEES) AND SECTION 13.12.140(A) and 13.12.140(B) (CHARGES DESIGNATED) OF CHAPTERS 13.08 (UTILITY SERVICE) AND 13.12 (WASTEWATER COLLECTION AND TREATMENT), OF THE PALMER MUNICIPAL CODE.

THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance shall be of a permanent nature and shall become a part of the City of Palmer Code of Ordinances.

Section 2. Severability. If any provisions of this ordinance, or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Section 13.08.020(F) is hereby amended to read as follows:

F. 1. A sewer permit fee of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) and a water permit fee of three hundred seventy five dollars (\$375.00) shall be for each connection to the sanitary sewer system and public water supply.

2. There shall be one water utility service connection and one meter per residential dwelling unit and new building of an occupancy other than a dwelling unit.

Section 4. Section 13.12.140(A) is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. Connection fee--sewer \$300.00

Section 5. Section 13.12.140(B) is hereby amended to read as follows:


B. Connection fee--water \$375.00

Section 6. Publication and Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption. Publication shall be by making copies available to the public, and further it shall be published by being printed and included in the Palmer Municipal Code at its next regular supplementation and printing. Publication may also be made by posting a copy hereof on the City Hall bulletin board for a period of ten (10) days following its adoption. A notice of public hearing shall be given by such posting at least five (5) days before final passage.


