ORDINANCE NO. 494

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PALMER MUNICIPAL AIRPORT REGULATIONS, SECTION 400.04 (c), TO INCREASE TIE-DOWN FEES.

THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance shall be of a permanent nature and shall become a part of the City of Palmer Code of Ordinances.

Section 2. Severability. If any provisions of this ordinance, or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Section 400.04 (c) of the Palmer Municipal Airport Regulations is amended to read as follows:


The fee for a tie-down parking space shall be seventy-five dollars (\$75) per quarter, or any part thereof, payable in advance. As an option, the annual fee shall be two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), payable in its entirety in advance.


Section 4. Publication and Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective at midnight on March 31, 1996. Publication shall be by making copies available to the public, and further it shall be published by being printed and included in the Palmer Municipal Code at its next regular supplementation and printing. Publication may also be made by posting a copy hereof on the City Hall bulletin board for a period of ten (10) days following its adoption. A notice of public hearing shall be given by such posting at least five (5) days before final passage.
