## ORDINANCE NO. 582

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX "A" (AIRPORT REGULATIONS) OF THE PALMER MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SUBSECTION 400.04 (FEES) OF SECTION 400 (AIRCRAFT OPERATION).

THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance shall be of a permanent nature and shall become a part of the City of Palmer Code of Ordinances.

Section 2. Severability. If any provisions of this ordinance, or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Amendment of Subsection 400.04, Fees, is amended to read as follows:

400.04 Fees.

(a) All fees and payments will be made at the office of the airport manager which is located at 231 W. Evergreen Avenue. The unused portion of any fee will not be refunded.

(b) Impounded aircraft will be released only upon payment of all impound and storage costs, as determined by the airport manager.

© The fee for a tie-down parking space shall be seventy-five dollars per quarter, or any part thereof, payable in advance. As an option, the annual fee shall be two hundred fifty dollars, payable in its entirety in advance.

(d) The fee for long term use of a parking space on the large aircraft apron by large aircraft shall be twelve cents per square foot per year, with a minimum area of ten thousand square feet. The airport manager shall approve any such use and shall designate parking areas if available. Each agreement for this use is intended to be temporary and shall not exceed two years.

Section 4. Publication and Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption. Publication shall be by making copies available to the public, and further it shall be published by being printed and included in the Palmer Municipal Code at its next regular supplementation and printing.


Publication may also be made by posting a copy hereof on the City Hall bulletin board for a period of ten (10) days following its adoption. A notice of public hearing shall be given by such posting at least five (5) days before final passage.
