

## CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA

## ORDINANCE NO. 601

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PALMER MUNICIPAL CODE SUBSECTION 2.04.040D, INCREASING THE COMPENSATION FOR COUNCIL MEMBERS.

THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance shall be of a permanent nature and shall become a part of the City of Palmer Code of Ordinances.

Section 2. Severability. If any provisions of this ordinance, or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Subsection 2.04.040 D is hereby amended to read as follows:

D. The compensation of each council member shall be:

1. The mayor shall receive [~~seventy-five~~] **two hundred** dollars per regular meeting and each council member shall receive [~~fifty~~] **one hundred** dollars per regular meeting;

2. The mayor and each council member shall receive [~~ten~~] **twenty-five** dollars per special meeting.


**3. The mayor shall receive one hundred dollars per work session and each council member shall receive fifty dollars per work session.**


Section 4. Publication and Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective on October 13, 2003. Publication shall be by making copies available to the public, and further it shall be published by being printed and included in the Palmer Municipal Code at its next regular supplementation and printing. Publication may also be made by posting a copy hereof on the City Hall bulletin board for a period of ten (10) days following its adoption. A notice of public hearing shall be given by such posting at least five (5) days before final passage.
