ORDINANCE NO. 613

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PALMER MUNICIPAL CODE SUBSECTION 3.16.050 S, (A SUBSECTION OF THE EXCEPTIONS TO THE SALES TAX CODE)

THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance shall be of a permanent nature and shall become a part of the City of Palmer Code of Ordinances.


Section 2. Severability. If any provisions of this ordinance, or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.


Section 3. PMC 3.16.050 S is amended to read as follows (new language is underlined and deleted language is stricken out):

The maximum tax on contracts for the original construction of private buildings or private residences ~~or sale of equipment shall be ten dollars; and even though the single sale of those articles of tangible personal property may run into several thousands of dollars, only the first five hundred dollars shall be subject to tax~~ shall be based only on the first five hundred dollars of the contract price;

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
