ORDINANCE NO. 616

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12.16.010 (SKATEBOARDS, PROHIBITION AND REGULATION) OF TITLE 12 (STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND PUBLIC PLACES) OF THE PALMER MUNICIPAL CODE

The City of Palmer ordains:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance shall be permanent in nature and shall be incorporated into the Palmer Municipal Code.

Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Section 12.16.010 is hereby amended to read as follows (new language is underlined and deleted language is stricken out):


12.16.010 Skateboards, prohibition and regulation.


A. No person may operate a skateboard on:

1. Any arterial street;
2. A roadway open to vehicular traffic if a sidewalk or paved pathway is adjacent to such roadway; ~~and~~
3. City property (to include without limitation sidewalks, parks, and plazas) within fifty feet of South Alaska Street and South Colony Way south of Cedar Street and north of Fireweed Street; ~~and~~
4. The entire library grounds, including, without limitation, the sidewalks and parking lot.

Section 4. Effective Date. Ordinance No. 616 shall take effect upon adoption by the City of Palmer City Council.
