ORDINANCE NO. 647

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTION 6.14.055 (ANIMALS WHICH RESIDE OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS) OF TITLE 6 (ANIMALS) OF THE PALMER MUNICIPAL CODE

The City of Palmer ordains:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance shall be permanent in nature and shall be incorporated into the Palmer Municipal Code.

Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.


Section 3. Section 6.14.055 is hereby amended to read as follows (new language is underlined and deleted language is stricken out):


6.14.055 Animals which reside outside the city limits.

If an incident has been referred to the animal control board and the animal resides outside the city limits, the board shall follow its normal course and after rendering its determination, provide written notification of the board's findings to the animal control board or animal board of the municipality in which the animal resides. If the animal is in the possession of the city or has been impounded by the city, then the board can order that the animal be registered with the city or alternatively, if circumstances warrant, that the animal be humanely destroyed.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
