AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE OPERATING OF ANY VEHICLE UNLESS THE SAME COMPLIES WITH THE LAWS OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA: PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF ANY VEHICLE UNLESS THE OPERATOR THEREOF IS LICENSED AS AN OPERATOR OR CHAUFFEUR AS REQUIRED BY TERRITORIAL LAW: AND PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF ANY VEHICLE BY ANY PERSON WHOSE OPERATOR'S OR CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE HAS BEEN SUSPENDED, REVOKED OR REFUSED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA:

Section 1. No person shall operate any vehicle, or permit the same to be operated, on any street or highway unless the same complies with the laws of the Territory of Alaska.

Section 2. No person shall operate any vehicle unless he is licensed as an operator or chauffeur as required by the Territory of Alaska and unless he has any license so granted in his possession at all times while operating a vehicle, and no person shall violate any condition or privilege of such license. No person shall permit an unlicensed driver to operate any vehicle owned by him.

Section 3. No person whose operator's or chauffeur's license has been suspended, revoked or refused shall drive while such license is suspended, revoked or refused.

Section 4. It shall be unlawful to violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance and punishment for such violation shall be in accordance with the general ordinances of the City of Palmer in such cases made and provided.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its final reading and passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
