ORDINANCE NO. 84

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTION 3 OF SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 65 TO PROVIDE FOR THE BILLING AND COLLECTING FOR GARBAGE SERVICE TO BE DONE BY THE CITY OF PALMER, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Virgil A. Meehan, contractor for the hauling of garbage within the City of Palmer, heretofore has petitioned the City Council for a new arrangement in the billing and collecting for garbage hauling whereby the said contractor shall be relieved of such responsibility and the City of Palmer shall do such billing and collecting, retaining as a charge for such service fifteen percentum (15%) of all collections made, and

WHEREAS, the City Council having fully discussed the matter with the said contractor at a regular and public meeting of the City Council on the 25th day of November 1958, has agreed with said contractor to perform said billing and collecting as aforesaid.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALMER: Subsection 3 of Section 4 of Ordinance No. 65 is hereby amended to read as follows:

3. He shall deal directly with the customers he is to serve, performing such service by uniform agreements with such customers, and in general operating his business as a private enterprise; always provided, however, that the City may, with the consent of the contractor, perform the service, in its own name, of the mailing of bills and statements to the public, monthly or more often at the city's option, and the collecting of bills from the public for garbage service rendered, reserving to and retaining for the city fifteen percentum (15%) of all such collections not including sales taxes in such computation, as a service charge in the premises. When performing such billing and collecting, the City shall make reasonable effort to collect all accounts, but shall not be responsible for credit losses, disputed accounts or collection of bad debts where legal action or the services of a professional collector are necessary.

AN EMERGENCY is hereby declared to exist; the usual rules of procedure are suspended, and this Ordinance shall be read in full, and again by its title and placed upon its final passage by the approval of the Common Council of the City of Palmer.
