

CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA
 ORDINANCE NO. 89

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DUMPING OF CLINKERS, ASHES, CINDERS, CONCRETE OR ANY OTHER DEBRIS OR MATERIAL ON CITY STREETS AND ALLEYS OR IN ANY DITCHES, DRAINS OR GUTTERS.

No person shall dump or deposit any clinkers, ashes, concrete or any other debris or foreign material on any street or alley or in any gutter or drainage ditch; and no person shall create any obstruction in any ditch, drain or gutter that may hinder the passage of water therein.


Every person convicted of a violation of this Ordinance or any provision thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$300.00 or by imprisonment for not more than 30 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each act of violation and every day upon which such violation shall occur shall constitute a separate offense.

PASSED by the Common Council and approved by the Mayor of the City of Palmer, Alaska, this 14th day of July, 1959.


