

RESOLUTION NO. 13

WHEREAS, CARL C. BRIX, an original settler in the Matanuska Valley and an Attorney at Law, has granted, demised, and conveyed to the City of Palmer, Alaska, a city of the first class, a certain area of land consisting of APPROXIMATELY five (5) acres, located in the Palmer Precinct and more particularly described as follows:

Lot Number Three (3) in Section Thirty-four (34), Township Eighteen North (T18N), Range Two (2), East of Seward Meridian.

AND, WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Palmer, Alaska has accepted this grant and conveyance and the generous gift of the said CARL C. BRIX to be used as a public park for the recreation and pleasure of the residents of the City of Palmer, Alaska and adjacent areas,

AND, WHEREAS, the Common Council has given the name of BRIX Park to said area of land to be held in perpetuity and forever as a place of recreation and pleasure of the residents of Palmer and adjacent areas.

WHEREFORE, be it RESOLVED that this body, the Common Council of the City of Palmer, for and on behalf of the residents of Palmer, by this Resolution, express its everlasting thanks and gratitude to the said CARL C. BRIX for his generosity and the humanitarian and charitable impulse which prompted this gift.

Be it further RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be spread upon the permanent records of the City of Palmer, Alaska.
