

RESOLUTION NO. 33

RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA

WHEREAS, the Housing and Rent Act of 1947, as amended, provides that the provisions of Title 11 thereof shall cease to be in effect at the close of September 30, 1952, except that they shall cease to be in effect at the close of April 30, 1953, in any area which prior to or subsequent to September 30, 1952, is certified under subsection (1) of section 204 of this Act as a critical defense housing area; or in any incorporated city, town, or village which, at a time when maximum rents under this title are in effect therein, and prior to September 30, 1952, declares (by resolution of its governing body adopted for that purpose, or by popular referendum in accordance with local law) that a substantial shortage of housing accommodations exists which requires the continuance of federal rent control in such city, town, or village; and

WHEREAS, the City of _____ Alaska is an incorporated city in the Alaska Defense-Rental Area with maximum rents under Title 11 of said Act in effect therein, but has not been certified under subsection (1) of section 204 of the Act as a critical defense housing area; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of _____ Alaska at its regular meeting has determined that a substantial shortage of housing accommodations exists which requires the continuance of federal rent control in the City of _____, Territory of Alaska, it is, therefore, hereby

RESOLVED: that the City Council of the City of _____, Territory of Alaska, hereby declares that a substantial shortage of housing accommodations exists which requires the continuance of federal rent control in the City of _____, Territory of Alaska, and
