

RESOLUTION NO. 64

RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA

Accepting the elimination of a certain item of work remaining on the Alaska Public Works Project, Aaa 50-A-127, described as Construction of Water Works and Extensions and Improvements to Municipal System.

WHEREAS, the City of Palmer entered into a construction and sales agreement with the United States, which was passed and approved by the Common Council of the City of Palmer, the 23rd day of March, 1954, providing for the construction of a Public Works Project, consisting of construction of water works and extensions and improvements to the municipal water system; and

WHEREAS the United States has heretofore entered into an agreement, dated July 2, 1952 with the Arctic Plumbing and Heating; and

WHEREAS the Project has been substantially completed under the Plans and Specifications, providing for the construction of said Project by Thomas B. Bourne Associates of Anchorage, as revised; and

WHEREAS the Common Council of the City of Palmer and the United States are in accord with the deletion of the requirement for further protective backfilling of the 14-inch supply line in the three following places: the west end of the lower Bugge field, the southwest corner of the Eckhert property and the area near the Benson water trough. It is agreeable between the City of Palmer and the United States that further burial of the supply line at these places be deleted from the Plans and Specifications referred to above; and

WHEREAS the value of the work to be deleted in said contract between the Arctic Plumbing and Heating and the United States has been determined by an independent Contractor and the City of Palmer in an amount of \$800.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Palmer agrees and accepts the deletion of the further covering of the 14-inch supply line at the following places: the west end of the lower Bugge field, the southwest corner of the Eckhert property and the area near the Benson water trough; that said deletion be made by Change Order initiated by the United States and the amount of \$800.00 be deducted from the contract price of the project.

This resolution passed, approved and adopted by the council for the City of Palmer this 17th day of August, 1954.
