

RESOLUTION NO. 71

RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA

WHEREAS, the CITY OF PALMER, PALMER, ALASKA,  
(name of political subdivision)  
(herein called the "Political Subdivision"), through its  
COMMON COUNCIL AND MAYOR, desires to make  
(governing body)

formal application to the Auditor of Alaska (herein called the "Territorial Agency"), for inclusion of its eligible employees in an agreement between the Territory of Alaska and the Federal Security Administrator for the coverage of such eligible employees under the insurance system established by Title 11 of the Federal Social Security Act, as amended, in conformity with Section 218 thereof, and implemented by Chapter 95, Session Laws of Alaska 1951, and applicable Federal and Territorial regulations thereunder; and

WHEREAS, the political Subdivision desires to file such application and to enter into an agreement with the Territorial Agency containing terms and conditions whereby the Territorial Agency will take the necessary steps to extend to such eligible employees coverage under the said insurance system on behalf of the Political Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, a form of application and agreement between the Territorial Agency and the Political Subdivision containing the terms and conditions for the inclusion by the Territorial Agency of the said eligible employees under the coverage of said insurance system on behalf of the Political Subdivision has been submitted to this body for consideration and action;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Political Subdivision execute the aforesaid application and agreement and submit the same to the Territorial Agency for acceptance and that the Territorial Agency be, and it hereby is, requested to include all of said eligible employees of the Political Subdivision in an agreement between the Territory and the Federal Security Administration for the coverage of said employees under the insurance system established by Title 11 of the Federal Social Security Act, as amended or as may hereafter be amended; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that for the purpose of said application and agreement, Frank R. Connally, City Clerk, Box 165 Palmer,  
(name) (title) (address)  
Alaska, be, and he hereby is, designated as the Authorized Agent of the Political Subdivision and is hereby authorized and directed to execute a said application and agreement, as submitted, on behalf of the Political Subdivision and to forward the same to the Territorial Agency for acceptance and further action; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said Authorized Agent is further authorized and directed as the representative of the Political Subdivision to conduct all negotiations, conclude all arrangements and sign all agreements and instruments which may be necessary to carry out the letter and intent of the aforesaid application and agreement and in conformity with all applicable Federal and Territorial laws, rules and regulations.
