

RESOLUTION NO. 72

RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA

WHEREAS, on March 13, the City Council ordered the institution of proceedings for annexation into the City of Palmer of 40 acres of land contiguous to the South Boundry of the City and including therein the New Palmer High School, and

WHEREAS, for the main purpose for such annexation at this time is to furnish police and fire protection to said school, and

WHEREAS, a petition has been signed by more than 30% of the property owners in said area to be annexed, the same having been heretofore and on the 16th day of March 1956, filed in the District Court at Anchorage, Alaska according to law, and the court having ordered a hearing upon said petition in the District Court for the Third Division at Anchorage, Alaska, to be held on April 20, 1956 at the hour of 10:00 O'Clock A. M.,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that subject to the approval of the Court at said hearing to be held, a special election is hereby ordered for the purpose of determining the matter of annexation as above stated; that such election shall be held on April 24, 1956 and that notice and procedures for the same shall be made and followed by the City Clerk according to law and the election ordinance of the City of Palmer.

CLARA M. BUZBY, NAN C. CURTIS, AND LUCILLE H. CURRY are hereby appointed and named as judges of said election.
