RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA

WHEREAS, on March 13, 1956 the City Council ordered the institution of proceedings for annexation in to the City of Palmer of 40 acres of land contiguous to the South Boundary of the City and including therein the New Palmer High School, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a petition signed by more than 30% of the property owners in said area to be annexed, has been heretofore and on the 16th day of March 1956, filed in the District Court at Anchorage, Alaska according to law, the court having ordered a hearing upon said petition in the District Court for the Third Division at Anchorage, Alaska and the hearing on said petition having been held on April 20, 1956 at the hour of 10:00 A. M., and

WHEREAS, upon said hearing, no one appearing in opposition thereto, the court having ordered an election to be held on Tuesday the 29th day of May, 1956,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a special election is hereby ordered for the purpose of determining the matter of annexation as above stated; that such election shall be held as ordered by the Court on Tuesday May 29, 1956, and that notice and procedures for the same shall be made and followed by the City Clerk according to law and the election ordinance of the City of Palmer.

Lucill Mick, Katheryn Wilson and Clara M. Buzby are hereby appointed and named as judges of said election in the City.

William Zahradnicek, Harry Wimmer and Guy John are hereby appointed and named as judges of said election in the territory to be annexed.
