

RESOLUTION NO. 78

RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA

WHEREAS, petitions signed by more than twenty-five per cent of the registered voters of the City of Palmer at the last municipal election have been presented to the City Council of the City of Palmer, praying for the adoption of the City Manager Plan of government, and

WHEREAS, said petitions also state such additional facts as may tend to show good grounds for the adoption of such Plan, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed that the matter is of sufficient importance to allow the submission of the same to the qualified electors of the City of Palmer to determine whether the people of said City desire to adopt such Plan of government at the next general election,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the said question of whether or not the City of Palmer shall adopt the City Manager Plan of government shall be placed upon the ballots for the determination by the people of the City at said election;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution shall be posted in three public places within the boundaries of the City of Palmer at least thirty days prior to the day of such election,
