RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA

CONDUCT OF THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA
 IN ELECTION TO BE HELD AUGUST 26, 1958
 AND APPOINTING JUDGES AND CLERKS OF SAID
 ELECTION AND POLLING PLACE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA:

That the Co-op Recreation Hall be designated as the Polling place
 for the Primary & Special Election to be held August 26, 1958.

Precinct No. 1 which includes the incorporated limits of the City
 of Palmer, Alaska.

That said election to be held on August 26, 1958 shall be

(1) for the purpose of nominating candidates of the various
 political parties of Alaska for the following offices to wit:

A Governor of Alaska	One United States Representative
A Secretary of Alaska	Twenty State Senators
Two United States Senators	Forty State Representatives

(2) to adopt or reject, by separate ballot on each, the three
 propositions relating to statehood.

That Clara Buzby, Kathleen Moore, and Haleen Ingalls be appointed
 judges of this election and Patricia Moffit and Verna Leek be
 appointed clerks of the election.
