

RESOLUTION NO. 94

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

THAT the Mayor and the Councilmembers of the City of Palmer are hereby authorized to execute the following :

RIGHT OF ENTRY

The City of Palmer, Alaska, upon the Resolution of its Council, No. 95 passed on February 9, 1960, hereinafter called the "City", hereby grants to the State of Alaska, permission to enter upon the following described lands; upon the conditions and for the purposes hereinbelow set forth:

The City may or may not have an interest in the following described property, but consider themselves to be contract purchasers. The following document is executed subject to the foregoing.

A parcel of land in the Southeast 1/4 of section 18, Township 17 North, Range 2 East, Seward Meridian, more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the Westerly right of way line of the Alaska Railroad, said point being N 61 49'33" E, 2547.63 feet from the Southwest corner of said Section 18; Thence (1), N 57 02' W 42 feet; Thence (2), along a curve to the right, said curve having a radius of 2784.79 feet, to the intersection thereof with the Westerly property line described in the _____ to John Van Ryn, dated December 31, 1954, recorded in Book 25, Page 246 Palmer Precinct; Thence (3), Southerly along said property to the intersection thereof with Westerly right of way line of the Alaska Railroad; Thence (4), Northerly along said right of way line to the point of beginning. Containing 0.5 acres more or less.

Basis of bearings contained herein is the township line Township 17 North and Township 18 North, Seward Meridian.

The purpose of this grant of right of entry is to permit the State, its agents, employees and contractors, to enter upon the above described lands for the purpose of constructing a portion of the Palmer-Matanuska-Wasilla Road, Project No. S-0570(3) as shown on the attached sketch.

This permission is given for the further purpose of giving the State immediate right of entry to the said lands and it is understood that the State will purchase said lands from the City, and the City shall convey by Warranty Deed, said lands, in consideration of the payment of Fifty and 00/100 (\$55.00) Dollars to the City by the State upon notice to the State from the City that title to said lands has vested in the City.
