RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALMER. ALASKA:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CREMATION OF CERTAIN ENUMERATED UNSOLD BONDS.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Palmer:

WHEREAS, Section 13-1-9, ACLA 1959 Cumulative Supplement authorized the destruction of records without legal, administrative, or historical interest, and

WHEREAS, by virtue of the provisions of Ordinance No. 72 certain general obligation street improvement bonds were authorized to be issued, but twenty-two of such bonds still remain unsold, and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk, having legal custody of said unsold bonds with coupons attached has presented a list of such bonds to the Council, requesting authorization to cremate such bonds, their having no further value and the Council not desiring them to be sold.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Clerk be, and she hereby is, authorized to cremate such bonds and coupons, making a complete record listing each such bond so cremated and preserving such descriptive list, together with a record of the place and manner of disposal, among the permanent records of the City, furnishing to the Council a list of the bonds so cremated and a copy of the record of the cremation itself.
