RESOLUTION NO. 116

Authorizing filing of application with the United States of America for an advance to provide for the planning of public works under the terms of Public Law 560, 83rd Congress of the United States, as amended.

WHEREAS, City of Palmer, Alaska (herein called the "Applicant") after thorough consideration of the various aspects of the problem and study of available data has hereby determined that the construction of certain public works, generally described as:

Sewage treatment works consisting of sewage lagoons, interceptors and outfall structures and collector lines and such other appurtenances as may be required for a complete sewer system

is desirable and in the public interest and to that end it is necessary that action preliminary to the construction of said work be taken immediately; and

WHEREAS, under the terms of Public Law 560, 83rd Congress, as amended, the United States of America has authorized the making of advances to public bodies to aid in financing the cost of engineering and architectural surveys, designs, plans, working drawings, specifications or other action preliminary to and in preparation for the construction of public works; and


WHEREAS, the applicant has examined and duly considered such act and the applicant considers it to be in the public interest and to its benefit to file an application under said act and to authorize other action in connection therewith;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA, the governing body of said applicant, as follows:


RESOLUTION NO. 116 (Cont'd)

1. That the construction of said public works is essential to and is to the best interests of the applicant, and to the end that such public works may be provided as promptly as practicable it is desirable that action preliminary to the construction thereof be undertaken immediately;
2. That Winston A. Gilchrist, City Manager, be hereby authorized to file in behalf of the applicant an application (in form required by the United States and in conformity with said act) for an advance to be made by the United States to the applicant to aid in defraying the cost of plan preparation for the above described public works, which shall consist generally of: Sewage treatment works consisting of sewage lagoons, interceptors and outfall structures and collector lines.
3. That if such advance be made, the applicant shall provide or make necessary arrangements to provide such funds, in addition to the advance, as may be required to defray the cost of the plan preparation of such public works;
4. The said Winston A. Gilchrist, City Manager, is hereby authorized to furnish such information and take such action as may be necessary to enable the applicant to qualify for the advance;
5. That the officer designated in the preceding paragraph is hereby designated as the authorized representative of the applicant for the purpose of furnishing to the United States such information, data and documents pertaining to the application for an advance as may be required; and otherwise to act as the authorized representative of the applicant in connection with this application.
6. That certified copies of this resolution be included as part of the application for an advance to be submitted to the United States.

 and Endorsing Checks to Matanuska Valley Bank

We, Willard Johnson and Emilie St. Pierre, the Mayor Pro Tempore and City Clerk-Treasurer, respectively, of the City of Palmer, a Municipal Corporation do hereby certify that we are the duly elected, qualified and Acting Mayor Pro Tempore and City Clerk-Treasurer of said Corporation and that the following is a full true and correct copy of certain resolutions duly and legally adopted at a meeting of the City Council thereof convened and held in accordance with law and the by-laws of said Corporation on the 23rd day of April, 1963, at which a quorum was present, and that such resolutions are now in full force and effect and duly recorded in the minutes of said City Council:

First: Resolved that Matanuska Valley Bank be and it hereby is selected as a depository for the funds of this Corporation and that a bank account or accounts, shall be opened and kept with the said bank in the name of this Corporation under the following designation or designations: CITY OF PALMER GENERAL FUND, WATER FUND, PROPERTY TAX FUND, and the following Savings Accounts: PROPERTY TAX FUND, WATER FUND, GENERAL FUND, ACCRUED LEAVE ACCOUNT, AND DEPRECIATION FUND, and that endorsements for deposit may be made by the written or stamped endorsement of the Corporation without designation of the person making the endorsement.
