RESOLUTION NO. 123

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA:

WHEREAS, the development of a coal-fired steam electric generating facility at Sutton, Alaska, is of utmost importance to the Southcentral Alaska electric power supply, and by utilizing an otherwise under-developed but abundant coal resource, would provide jobs and economic opportunities necessary to strengthen the depressed economy of the Matanuska Valley, thereby fulfilling the historic role and purposes of the Rural Electrification Administration.

IT IS THEREFORE DECLARED to be the policy of this City to urge, support and cooperate in the construction of this generation facility in every way within its powers, and

It is respectfully requested that the Rural Electrification Administration include this project within its program.

It is further resolved signed copies of this Resolution be transmitted to Norman M. Clapp, REA Administrator, U. S. Department of Agriculture, Washington 25, D. C., and to Senators Bartlett and Gruening and Representative Rivers.
