RESOLUTION NO. 146

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALMER,  
ALASKA, MAKING APPLICATION TO THE ALASKA STATE HOUSING  
AUTHORITY FOR PLANNING ASSISTANCE.

WHEREAS, the Palmer City Council in cooperation with the Matanuska-Susitna Borough desires to provide for a planning study contributing to an overall program for future community development, the preservation of community values, the prevention of conditions tending to cause urban blight, and the promotion of the general health, safety and welfare of its citizens, and

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Housing Authority, under authority of Alaska Statutes 18.55.970 et seq., may provide planning assistance for such a program and receive financial assistance from the Urban Renewal Administration, as authorized by Section 701 of the Housing Act of 1954 (Public Laws, 83rd Congress), as amended.


NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Palmer City Council hereby requests the Alaska State Housing Authority to provide planning assistance under the above authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:


1. That the Palmer City Council, subject to approval by the State and Federal authorities, hereby authorizes payment of a sum of \$2,000.00 in cash and furnishing services totalling \$2,750.00 to the Alaska State Housing Authority, the total estimated cost of the project as planned being \$62,000.00 with \$4,750.00 being the City's share, \$10,750.00 being Matanuska-Susitna Borough's share and \$46,500.00 being the Federal share;

2. That the City Manager be and is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the City of Palmer all necessary contracts and agreements to implement and carry out the purposes specified in this resolution.
