WHEREAS, The Council has considered the budget proposed by the City Manager for the 1966-1967 fiscal year of the City.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF PALMER RESOLVES:


Sec. 1. That the budget presented to the Council by the City Manager for the fiscal year 1966-1967 is adequate and acceptable and meets the needs of all municipal services for the ensuing fiscal year.

Sec. 2. That the 1966-1967 budget as presented is hereby adopted and the monies stated therein for the enumerated items are hereby appropriated in the amounts and for the purposes stated in the said budget.

Publication of this Resolution shall be made by posting a copy hereof on the City Hall bulletin board for a period of ten days following its passage and approval.
