RESOLUTION NO. 174

A RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING RECEIPT OF A PETITION FOR A WATER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICTED LOCATED ON EAST FIREWEED AVENUE FROM SOUTH DENALI STREET TO SOUTH CHUGACH STREET, SETTING DATE OF PUBLIC HEARING THEREON, AND DIRECTING PUBLIC NOTICE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, a petition for the creation of a water improvement district on East Fireweed Avenue from South Denali Street to South Chugach Street, and calling for the installation of approximately 432 feet of water main, has been presented to the City Council, and the City desires to acknowledge the same;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Palmer:

1. The petition is in due form and signed by the apparent owners of at least one-half in value of the property to be specially benefited by the water main installation, as required in Section 8.2(1) of the City Charter.

2. The City Manager has surveyed the proposed improvement area and reports that the improvement is desirable and needed, estimating the total project cost not to exceed more than three cents (3¢) per square foot for the property specially benefited, all as required by Section 8.2(3) of the City Charter.

3. In accordance with Section 8.2(3) of the City Charter, a public hearing shall be held at the City Council Chambers, City Hall, Palmer, Alaska, to determine the necessity of this local improvement, at 8 o'clock p.m. on the 12th day of September, 1967. The City Clerk shall, at least fifteen (15) days before such date, send a written notice by mail to each owner of a tract of land included within the improvement district, as their names appear on the current assessment roll, which notice shall state that a public hearing will be held at the above time and place, and the purpose thereof. The Clerk shall also publish a notice of said public hearing in a newspaper published in the City of Palmer at least once during the calendar week preceding the public hearing.

4. The proposed improvement district shall be tentatively designated as Water Improvement District No. 6, and the names of the persons executing the petition are as follows:
