A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO PLAN PROPOSED PAVING IMPROVEMENTS, AND DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO PUBLISH NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING.


THE CITY OF PALMER, ALASKA, RESOLVES, THAT:

1. The City Manager should survey and prepare plans for the paving of streets and public places in the proposed special improvement district described in the notice attached hereto, and report to the Council on the need for, the desirable extent of, and the estimated cost of paving the appropriate streets and public places therein.

It is further resolved that the City Clerk should publish the attached notice once a week for two consecutive weeks in The Frontiersman, commencing the first publication on at least sixty days before the 8th day of April, 1969; and should further mail copies of such notice to all owners and unknown owners of property included in the proposed improvement district as the same are shown on the latest borough tax assessment roll.

Publication of this resolution shall be by posting a copy of the same on the City Hall bulletin board for a period of ten (10) days.
