WHEREAS, one of the basic elements in promoting an advancing quality of life in our society is the leavening produced by ideas, information and experiences contained in books, and


WHEREAS, the City of Palmer and the surrounding community are fortunate in having an exceptionally well balanced library facility with which to promote this end, and
